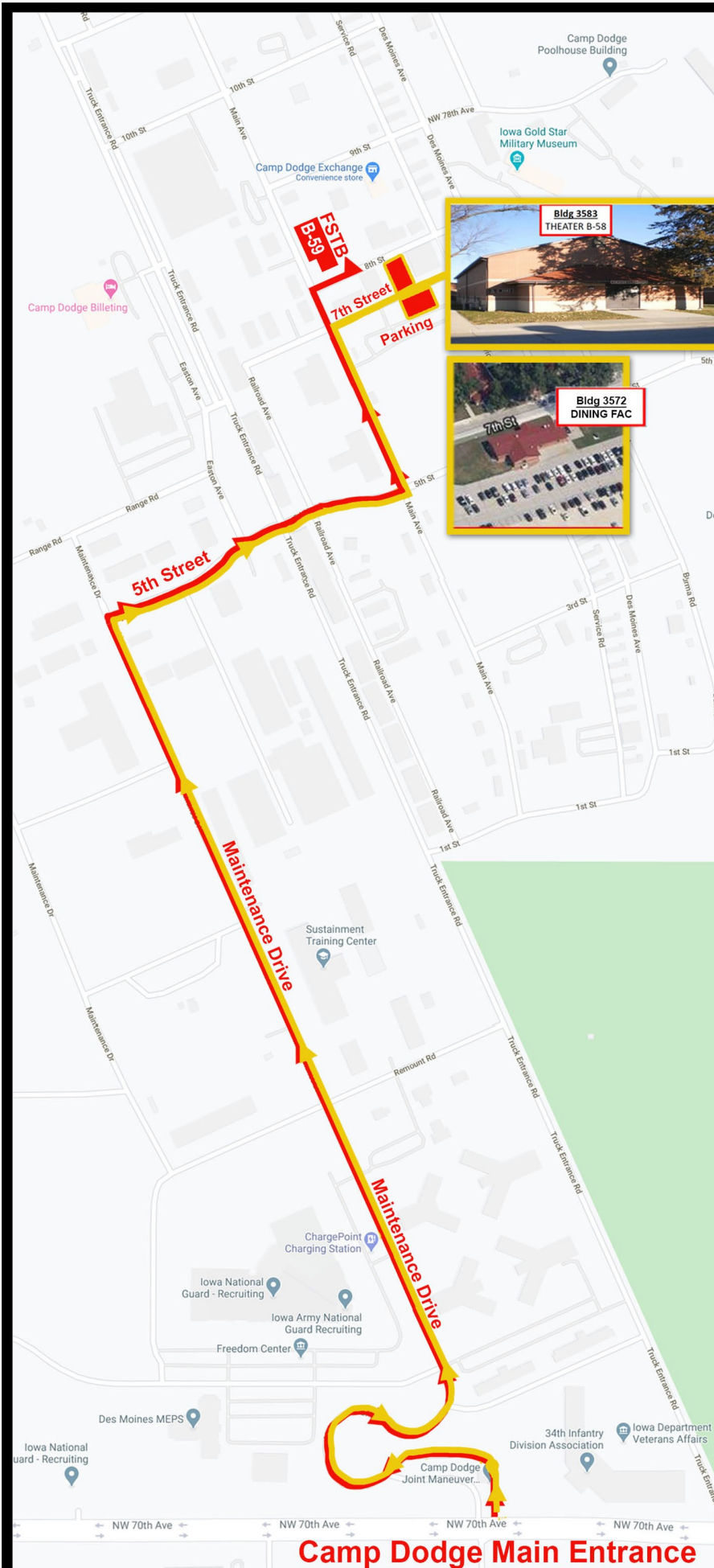

Topics that will be Covered

The Chief as an Influencer - Chiefs frequently have to interact with multiple partners in many different departments across their cities and agencies. Using the powers of persuasion and influence will assist them when working with others. Through the research of Robert Cialdini, participants will uncover the six styles of influence and how and when to use them to persuade others to act.

The Chief as a Roach Role Model - Chiefs are trained to spend time balancing budgets, organizing workflow and delivering results. Very few have time to stop and focus on the small details. But the details are usually the difference between a mediocre manager and a successful leader. Through a fascinating lesson from a simple roach, Pete will share six simple, yet essential traits that chiefs can emulate every day to improve their people, their product, and their property.

The Chief as an Engaged Employee - Fire Chiefs have to lead by example each and every day. The emotional roller coaster of leading people and managing projects can lead to disengagement. What does today's fire chief need to know to stay engaged each and every day in the workplace. In this session, Pete will explain the JOBS Model of Employee Engagement and share ways to keep yourself engaged each and every day.
